| sum | <i>I am</i> | eram | <i>I was</i> |
| es | <i>you are</i> | eras | <i>you were</i> |
| est | <i>he is</i> | erat | <i>she was</i> |
| sumus | <i>we are</i> | eramus | <i>we were</i> |
| estis | <i>you are</i> | eratis | <i>you were</i> |
| sunt | <i>they are</i> | erant | <i>they were</i> |
